#### The Burdens of Life

#### Psalm 13

We all have one very real thing in common; the burdens of life. They are real; they are a part of life; they weigh us down. The psalmist shares these difficult moments of life in the writings known as lament psalms. Lament simply means "to feel or express sorrow or regret; mourn for or over." It is those times in life when we cry out to God, "Where are you?" "Do you not see the deplorable condition we are in?" Do you not care about the pain we are dealing with?" Understand this my friends, we are not by ourselves. The psalmists expresses our exact feelings when he writes, "How long, O Lord? Will you forget me forever? How long will you hide your face from me? How long must I bear pain in my soul, and have sorrow in my heart all the day?" O yes, we can identify with that because we have been there too. Facing the burdens of life is where our faith and trust in God comes into play. It is where we show the world we are God's people; that he gives us the strength and courage to endure our time of suffering. That is why Jesus instructs us "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls" (Matt. 11:28-29). It is only in him that we find hope in dealing with the burdens of life. No matter how difficult the burdens of life become, we must believe that God is still there to rescue us and see us through. That is exactly what the psalmist did. "But I have trusted in your steadfast love; my heart shall rejoice in your salvation, I will sing to the Lord, because he has dealt bountifully with me." Yes, it is OK to express our grief and sorrow to the Lord, but we must also trust in his power to save us from our burdens of life. Praise God for his Gordon Salvation!
