**Revealing God
A Son was Born**

Carol and I were married seventeen days when I went to Vietnam for a year. After the Lord delivered me safely back home, we decided to wait a couple of years to have children to give us time to enjoy our life of "oneness." Well, our family and friends began to wonder why we were not having children, thinking something was wrong.

I am sure that is what was going through the minds of Abraham and Sarah during the 25 years after God promised that he would be the father of many nations. It was beginning to look like one of his slaves would be his heir. God again assured Abraham he would have descendants as numerous as the stars in heaven (Gen. 15:5). Then God told Abraham "I will give you a son by Sarah; I will bless her, and she shall be a mother of nations; kings of peoples shall come from her" (Gen. 17:16). At that point in our lives, we would have done the same thing Abraham did. He "laughed and said to himself, 'Shall a child be born to a man who is a hundred years old? Shall Sarah, who is ninety years old, bear a Child?'" (Gen. 17:17). Don't you know our God is a patient God! He again assured Abraham he would have a son, and they were to name him Isaac (Gen 17:19). When God promises us something, we must learn to be patient, just as he is, to wait for the fulfillment in his time. Peter reminds us of this fact when he tells us "...with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day" (2 Pet. 3:8). Then came the blessed day for all humanity when **a son was born** to Abraham and Sarah. "And Sarah conceived, and bore Abraham a son in his old age at the time of which God had spoken to him" (Gen. 21:2). God's promise was fulfilled, and we are also heirs of that amazing promise. Yes, at the right time God blessed Carol and I with four wonderful children.
