Revealing God - A Savior

The Word Became Flesh

Words are a precious part of our human lives. We speak words to a new born child, and we are touched when they respond with eye contact, a smile, or some body movement. Then comes a defining moment when the new life speaks their first words. You see, words communicate, they guide, provide encouragement, discipline, and express our love for others. Yes, words are our life.

The apostle John opens the door to an eternal dimension of the "Word." He tells us, "And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth; we have beheld his glory, glory as the only Son from the Father" (Jn. 1:14). The words we speak have a heavenly connection. Jesus, as our Lord and Savior, is the Word that brought the world into existence. "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God; all things were made through him, and without him was not anything made that was made" (Jn. 1:1-3). That means, even the words we speak were created by him, so we must be mindful of the way we use them, and respect their eternal value. When Adam and Eve responded to the deceitful words of the serpent, they sinned and were removed from the presence of God. Fallen humanity continued to struggle in their relationship with God, because they kept failing to obey his Words. Then, the Word became flesh to restore our severed relationship with the Creator. The Word has brought us eternal salvation, and as John tells us, we can now behold the glory of the Word, God's only Son. As the apostle Paul writes, Jesus did not count his "equality with God something to be grasped,... And being found in human form he humbled himself and became obedient unto death, even death on a cross" (Phil. 2:6 & 8). We are eternally blessed the Word became flesh!
