Ezra 3:1-6

Sermon Thought:

The Jews built the altar as one of their first official acts. On the altar, items were given or surrendered to God. The sacrifices demonstrated that the people were seeking God and rededicating themselves to living as he commanded. They realized the importance of obeying God from the heart, not merely out of habit. If we want God’s help, we must make staying close to him our top priority.
