Dear Brethren.

When I attend various brotherhood seminars, conferences, & other gatherings, I am blessed to visit with members of the church from all over the US. Many of these individuals are from congregations that support the work at Westview. At a recent event, in the mountains of New Mexico, as I made contact with such individuals, I realized that I need to share with you what I share regularly with them. I tell them about how we have had boys go on mission trips & how those trips strengthen their spiritual growth. I tell them about one of our young men who went through the Adventures in Missions program & how he spent an extended period of time working alongside a missionary serving the inner-city of Miami. Now that "boy" is an adult with a family of his own. He is a faithful Christian, & every day I see his social media posts that either quote scripture or ask theological questions he had been trying to work through. Thank you for your faithful support of Westview Boy's Home. Through your support, we are able to provide for all of the needs of the young men entrusted to our care. You give the ability to open doors of opportunities for spiritual growth in the lives of our boys. Camps, mission trips, & being part of an extended mission program all bring amazing growth to the lives of our boys, & you play a big role in making such growth possible.

During my recent trip to the mountains, I met a man who is now in his sixties. He had been at Westview back in the 1970s. He remembered not only which house he lived in while at Westview, but he remembered the room numbers. Today, he is a full-time preacher for a congregation in Texas, & he has been a preacher for a long time. Those who supported Westview back in the 70s influenced his life, much li8ke you are influencing the lives of boys today. Through their influence back then, he has spent decades bringing others to Christ and ministering to people in their time of need. I am convinced that someday you will be able to look back at today, realizing that boys you helped today have played a role in expanding the Kingdom, & that you had a hand in that. Thank you for all you do for our boys & the church.
