# A Light to the World

It is only with light that we are able to move around and function in life. When we are in total darkness, we are lost and in danger of hurting our human bodies. We need light to accomplish the things we need to do, and fulfill God's plan for us. In the spiritual realm of God's creation, light is again essential for us to know where we are going and carry out his work. Jesus tells us, "You are the light of the world... Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven" (Matt. 5:14 & 16).

To maintain God's presence with his people and to carry out his will, he established the Lord's Church to be a light to the world. On the rock of Peter's confession that Jesus was "the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Matt. 16:16-18), the Lord's Church was built. Christ is the head of the church (Eph. 5:21), and is the source of its light. As John writes, "The true light that enlightens every man was coming into the world. He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world knew him not" (Jn. 1:9-10). It is, therefore, the duty of the church to make known Jesus as our Lord and Savior. The apostle Paul testifies of this purpose and his ministry in the Lord's Church: "to make all men see what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God who created all things; that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places. This was according to the eternal purpose which he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord, in whom we have boldness and confidence of access through our faith in him" (Eph. 3:9-12). That my friends, as a light to the world that the Lord's Church provides, shinning glorious light on the eternal salvation we have in Christ. May each day be brighter by the light that shines in us.
